It's a place where everyone comes together regardless of race or income to engage in competitive, healthy sport. Our gym was recently renovated in partnership with the Boston Celtics, and is a great place to play. Participants in our leagues learn the fundamentals of the game through practices and gameplay, as well as valuable life skills including teamwork, sportsmanship, and self-confidence. Our YBL for younger children and Middle School students is an in-house league, while the High School League travels to play other leagues in the Lynn region. Uniforms are provided, and no child is turned away for lack of ability to pay.
